

Stocky Alternatives — Comparison

As of 2026-08-27 | Compiled from each vendor's public website and Shopify App Store listing. Prices and features change, so **please verify against the current pages when you actually make a decision**. Source URLs and the date each was checked are in the footnotes.

Stocky — the inventory app bundled with Shopify POS Pro — **ends on 31 August 2026, and every Stocky API stops that day**. Stocky then remains read-only for export for at least 90 days, but suppliers cannot be exported from Stocky. This table lines up the main migration candidates. It also includes **Shopify's own native purchasing features (built into the admin, no extra cost)**, since that is the default destination for many stores.

Read this before comparing. UreyukiBox works for ordinary Shopify stores in and outside Japan. Screens and purchase-order PDFs follow the Shopify admin language; notifications follow the store's country. Seasonality is scoped to 51 country calendars and editable purchase-tax presets cover 53 countries. Japan-specific registration fields are an extra where applicable, not a prerequisite for using migration, purchasing, receiving or inventory workflows. Support is available in Japanese and English.

※ UreyukiBox migration guarantee: if the Stocky API copy cannot be completed for reasons on our side, we refund the full subscription fee for the billing month immediately following the migration. The independent Stocky CSV import and pasted MOQ/Statistics tables are excluded (see the terms of service). ※ UreyukiBox's API route is available only through 31 August 2026. It retains normalized suppliers, every PO/adjustment parent and line, tax types and each saved record's API-acquired payload, and reconstructs product-supplier candidates from PO history. Sales-purpose tax types do not affect current purchase-tax settings, and current-product tax assignments are not changed. Independently, from 1 September Stocky CSV import accepts Low Stock, every retained stocktake, the PO list plus individual POs, adjustments, Stock on hand, available Transfers, Average cost and other exports, plus merchant-created supplier, product-term and purchase-tax CSVs. Vendor Order limits and Statistics also accept pasted tables; manual notes and evidence are stored separately. CSV originals, pasted MOQ/Statistics source text, source conditions and parseable rows are browsable in Stocky data's six merchant-facing categories and exportable as CSV/PDF; generic normalized rows outside the plan are masked by the server. API stock adjustments alone are not treated as stocktake history. Notes, supplier notes and PO notes unavailable through Stocky's API/CSV are retained manually with evidence. ※1 Current native functionality documented in Shopify's official Stocky transition guide (source in footnotes). ※2 The same guide states that historical POs cannot be imported into Shopify, Stocky remains read-only for export for at least 90 days after shutdown, and suppliers cannot be exported (source in footnotes).

Where UreyukiBox genuinely fits — and where it does not

It fits when you sell in Japan.

1. **Prices are fixed by Shopify billing currency.** JPY-billed stores pay ¥0–¥12,800; every non-JPY store pays \$0–\$83 per month. These are separate fixed plan prices, not an estimated currency conversion.
2. **Purchase orders use the store's configured purchase-tax rates.** They print tax-by-rate detail and the applicable registration number; a zero-rate country does not get a misleading tax section.
3. **Stocky preservation has two independent routes.** Through 31 August the API copy retains supported parent/line records and per-record API-acquired payloads. From 1 September Stocky CSV import accepts supported exports and merchant-created supplier, product-term and purchase-tax CSVs; MOQ/Statistics also accept pasted tables, while manual notes and evidence are stored separately. Stocky data provides browse, search and CSV/PDF export across six merchant-facing categories; generic normalized rows outside the plan are masked by the server. If we cannot complete the API copy for reasons on our side, we refund the billing month immediately following the migration; the independent Stocky CSV import and pasted MOQ/Statistics tables are excluded. Stores that never used Stocky skip migration entirely.

Stores outside Japan can use the same purchasing and migration workflows. The interface and documents follow the Shopify admin language, seasonality is scoped to the store's country, and purchase-tax presets cover 53 countries. Japan-specific invoice fields appear only where applicable; they are not a requirement for using the app.

- **Assisty** — closer to a reporting / BI tool at its core, with weaker purchase-order automation (as reviewed May 2026; verify current state).
